Paws and Claws

English	This term we will use the "What Do You See?" books to innovate and write our own stories. We will use these books to focus on consoldating and extending our knowldge of adjectives and how they can be used to enhance our writing.
Maths	Our units for this term are place value within 50, lenth and height and mass and volume. Children will be developing their place value knowledge of tens and ones as well as exploring measurement.
Science	This term in Science our focus will be 'animals including humans'. We will learn about the difference between various species of animal and how to classify them, as well as the human body.
Geography	We will be consolidating and extending on previous knowledge about the seasons, continents and oceans. We will be learning about the Equator and the poles and comparing these places.
Art/DT	In Design and Technology we will be learning about sliders and levers. We will be creating a moving picture based on an animal in the different seasons.
Music	In Music we will be using Charanga to explore the unit 'Learning to Listen'. We will be exploring how to listen and respond to music and how to listen to others.
Computing	Children will be 'learning to code'. They will develop an understanding of coding - giving a robot instructions and will have a go at coding some simple programmes.
R.E.	For this term we will be continuing to explore "What makes some places sacred?". We will be making comparrisons amongst different religions and our own beliefs, as well as exploring music from different religions and their meaning behind it.
P.E.	This term children will be introduced to the gymnasitcs and net and wall games, focussing on small and long pathways.
Personal Development	This term the focus is on resilience, independance and tolerance alongside developing an understanding of community and values.
