Busy Bugs

English	We will be using the 'Bug Hotel' text to write instructions on how to care for bugs and what bugs require to survive. We will create a Pearewood Bug Newsletter and send it to Hamza Yassin.
Maths	This term, pupils will be learning about about mass and capacity, temperature and time as well as recapping the four operations. In addition to this we will be applying these skills to word problems.
Science	Our focus in Science will be around living things and their habitats. We will be learning about food chains, habitats and micro habitats.
Geography History	In Geography, we will be planning, carrying our and evaluating our own fieldwork using David Attenborough and Hamza Yassin as an inspiration. In the History part of this unit the children will be looking at changes through living memory, with how exploration of the natural world has changed over time.
Art/DT	In Art, we will be using our learning from Term 1 to apply to line drawings of different bugs and animals learnt classified throughout our topic.
Music	We will be comparing beats, pulse and pitch and then using this knowledge to recreate sounds that we think different insects make when they move. We will use different instruments to do this and perform these in class.
Computing	Year 2 will be focusing on technology used both inside and outside of the classroom and will be exploring how we can use our iPads outside of the classroom and what skills we already have that can support us with this.
R.E.	The children will be learning about the beliefs within the Islamic faith with the focus on the key question: Who is a Muslim and what do they believe? We will be comparing these to other faiths we have covered and our own beliefs.
P.E.	In PE pupils will be learning how to improve our hand eye co-ordination through target games. We will also be developing our gymnastic skills.
Personal Development	This term focuses on physical health and well being, growing, keeping safe online and curiosity and character in Character Education.
