Children will be immersed in Saxon and Viking History, with a visit from the Time Capsule

Children will be sharing mythical stories with their parents as well as showing parents how use Sphero for coding.

Learning Outside of the Classroom

Re-enact a Viking Battle on the launch day.

Children will be writing a deafeating the monster tale, writing an infromation text about diffrent mythical monsters from **English** Anglo-Saxon times. Pupils will also cover adding, subtracting and estimating money. They will recap telling the time to the nearest minute, **Maths** using a.m. and p.m., using a 24 hour clock. Children will also be revisiting shape and lines of symmetry. Children will begin to learn about frictional forces and magnetics. They will look at how magnets attract or repel each **Science** other dependant on the poles and will explore how different materials are either magnetic or non-magnetic. Friction will be explored by seeing how different materials move on different surfaces. Invasion, Invasion, Invasion! In History, we will be exploring the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. We will be focusing on where they originated from, why **History** they came to settle in Britain and their influence on how we live today. Children will continue to focus on creating different textures and colours, making deliberate choices for their colour Art/DT choices. They will design their own Viking sail which will be combined with all of the classes designs to create one big Viking sail to add to a Viking longboat for their final display. Children will be working with glockenspiels, building on their music theory including note names and symbols, their Music equivalent rests and time signatures. Children will be using algorithms using Sphero coding. They will be building on their coding knowledge from last term to **Computing** complete tasks using Sphero. Children will be learning about what we can learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong and looking at a R.E. range of religions and their beliefs. Gymnastics and athletics is the focus for this term. Children will be working with a partner to practice pushing and pulling P.E. and working collaboratively. **Personal** Children will be looking at pride, aspiration and achievement in their PD sessions. We will also cover ways to keep ourselves fit and healhty, both mentally and physically. **Development**
