



**Year 6 Spring 2**  
**Rule of Law**

**Big Bang**

**Rule of Law**

<b>English</b>	This term, pupils will be revising the full EGPS curriculum for Year 5 and 6. They will then apply this knowledge to writing a mystery in the form of an alternative ending to the book Holes. After this, they will be writing a persuasive leaflet advertising Camp Green Lake as a destination to visit.
<b>Maths</b>	Pupils will be refining their times tables skills and ensuring they are confident applying these to fractions, decimals and percentages. They will also develop their knowledge of measure.
<b>Science</b>	In Science, we will be consolidating our learning from previous terms.
<b>History</b>	In History, children will learn about the rule of law, looking at different punishments for different crimes throughout the ages. They will give their opinions on these and learn about a historical figure.
<b>Art/DT</b>	In Art/DT, we will be using digital media to create art linked to our topic.
<b>Music</b>	This term, children will continue learning to play the ukuleles, developing skills including tuning, counting in time, playing chords and reading music with confidence.
<b>Computing</b>	In computing, pupils will be learning how to code and will apply their HTML coding skills to create a web page about their current wider curriculum topic.
<b>R.E.</b>	In RE, children will look at the difference between believing in ahimsa, grace and/or Ummah.
<b>P.E.</b>	Children will be focusing on Tag Rugby and Gymnastics this term. They will learn to collaborate in teams and learn different gymnastics poses.
<b>Personal Development</b>	This term the focus is on independence. Pupils will focus on resilience, money debt, well-being, and tolerance.
