Migration

English

This term, we will be using our class text to learn more about migration. We will be writing for a range of purposes, such as writing a diary entry from the perspective of a refugee and an interview asking open-ended questions.

Maths

In Summer 2, the children will apply their learning throughout the year to different word problems. They will also be learning about salaries, bills and mortgages.

Science

In Science this term, children will be learning about Electricity. They will learn to associate the brightness of a lamp or volume of a buzzer with the number of voltage cells used in the circuit. In some lessons, they will use the iPads to demonstrate their learning about electricity.

Humanities

In Humanities, children will learn what migration is and the history of migration. They will look at how people have travelled throughout history and the different reasons for travel, such as trade, war and adventure.

Art/DT

In Art, children will be building on their drawing skills and working the style of an artist (Chuck Close). They will create an original piece of artwork which includes the use of a digital image, drawing, colouring and collaging, showcasing all of the art skills they have learnt.

Music

In Music, we will be learning how to use the glockenspiels and the children will learn how to play a song to perform to the rest of the class.

Computing

In Summer 2, the children will be looking at mastering networks and data. They will recap key concepts to solidify their understanding and learn about data security measures like firewalls. They will also learn how large sets of data are managed and analysed.

R.E.

In R.E, we will be focusing on our question: "What do religions say to us when life gets hard?" We will be looking at how to manage with problems that arise inside and outside of school.

P.E.

In P.E, we will be working on yoga, focusing on spatial awareness, and cricket. Children will also start preparing for Sports Day competitions.

Personal Development

In Personal Development this term, the children will learn about physical health and well-being and how the body changes through puberty. They will also partake in transition activities to ensure that they are ready for their Secondary school.
