English	This term pupils will be using the text Jim and the Bean Stalk to explore a range of traditional tales. We will be using these texts to explore adjectives; describing characters and settings. We will be innovating and writing our own Jack and the Beanstalk story.
Maths	This term Year 1 will be focusing on numbers within ten. This includes the place value of the numbers and using them in addition and subtraction.
Science	Science this term will focus on plants and seasonal changes. We will explore the different seasons and their features. We will also be learning about the parts of a plant and what plants need to grow.
- Humanities -	In humanities this term Year 1 will be focusing on geography. In geography they will be learning about the United Kingdom and its capital cities. They will investigate their local area first, then London and after that moving onto the different countries within the UK.
Art/DT	In Art we will be learning about different types of paint and how to create colour and tone through mixing. We will explore primary and secondary colours and different types of brush strokes through artists Mondrian and Kadinsky.
Music	In music we will be learning about controlling sounds through singing and playing instruments, including performing.
Computing	This term in computing will be mainly focussing on e-safety. We will begin to learn how to use the basic functions of an iPad. This also includes how to hold it and take care of it.
R.E.	Our 'key question' in RE this term is "Who is a Christian and what do they believe?".
P.E.	This term the focus in PE is developing fundamental movement skills. We will also be exploring gymnastics, with a focus on balancing and spinning on points and patches.
Personal  Development	In health and relationships this term we will be learning about who in our community looks after us. In Character Education we will be focusing on respect and honesty.
