English	This term pupils will be using the text <b>One Plastic Bag.</b> They will be focusing on the use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops while emphasising the use of phonics for their spelling.
- Maths	This term pupils will be continuing to learn about addition and subytraction within ten and securing their knowledge of number bonds to ten. We will also be focussing on how we can use maths manipulates to support us in our learning. We will end the term learning about 2D and 3D shapes.
Science	Science this term will focus on developing our knowledge of plants and seasonal change. We will be exploring evergreen and deciduous trees and having a look at how plants change in the different seasons.
Geography	In Geography will be learning the names and locations of the seven continents and five oceans. We will also be having a look at the impact of climate change and ocean pollution around the world.
Art/DT	In Art/DT, the children will be learning how to make patterns and prints before creating their own design inspored by the illustrations and clothing in the class text <b>One Plastic Bag</b> .
Music	In Music, we will be exploring rhythm and rap through the Charanga unit 'Dance, Sing and Clap'. We will be continuing to secure the skill of finding the pulse to a song and moving in different ways to a beat and rhythms.
Computing	Pupils will learning how to use the Camera and Keynote apps on the iPad.
R.E.	For this term, our key question is 'How and why do we celebrate special and sacred times? They will look at how special times are celebrated differently.'
P.E.	Target games and continuing to develop fundamental skills is the focus of PE sessions this term.
Personal Development	This term the focus is on collaboration and teamwork. Pupils will focus on how to be aware of their peers, their strength and how working together can result in great work and ideas.
